Four times a year, on Yom Kippur, Shemini Atzeret, Passover, and Shavuot, we gather to remember the lives of our loved ones who are no longer with us. The pages of this booklet contain a brief service that allows for personal reflection and prayer. Dearly departed family members and friends are recalled in our hearts and in our memories.

The first Yizkor book was published after the First Crusade of 1096. It was a way for the Jewish community to publicize and memorialize those who had died by the sword of the Crusading armies. Over the course of time, Jews have continued this tradition of recording the names of loved ones in books so that communities would recall those who had entered the realm of memory. The booklet you hold in your hand is part of this tradition. Each name represents a holy spark of the Divine.

When we recite Yizkor we make mention of each person individually. We do not lump our loved ones together and say "May God remember the souls of my parents and my siblings and all my relatives." Instead, we say the Yizkor prayer over and over again – once for a mother with her name and then once again for a father with his name and then once again for a brother with his name and so on. Each one gets an individual Yizkor. Why? Because each one was an individual, each one was a person, and each one was special in his/her own way. Every human being deserves to be treated as such in life and in death.

Yizkor Tradition: אָדָקָה (тzedakah)

The Yizkor service was historically called *Seder Matnat Yad*, the service of expressing generosity on behalf of those who have died. That name comes from the closing line of the Torah reading for the final day of the pilgrimage festivals (when Yizkor is recited): "Every person giving a gift according to the blessing they have received from Adonai" (Deuteronomy 16:17). Offering charitable gifts and performing acts of justice, love, and care in memory of those who have died provide us with ways of honoring their memory and continuing their influence for good.

On Miscarriage Or Stillbirth

May the name for the Source of Creation be magnified and my pain grow less and less. Master of mercy, cover them in the cover of Your wings forever and may their souls be bound up in the bonds of life. God is their inheritance, may their rest be in Gan Eden, and let them rest in peace upon their places of repose, and let them stand for their fate in the end of days. And let us say Amen.

THE YAHRZEIT (Anniversary of a Death)

The observance of the *yahrzeit* is one of the honors a Jew can pay to departed parents and loved ones. It is a *mitzvah* that our heart, mind and conscience bids us to fulfill with love and respect.

- 1. *Yahrzeit* is observed on the anniversary of the day of death according to the Hebrew calendar. The *yahrzeit* begins at sundown, just as Shabbat and all Jewish holidays begin.
- 2. The mourner's *kaddish* is recited at services during the day of *yahrzeit*. The *kaddish* elevates the soul every year to a higher paradise and assures participation in the congregation of the Jewish people.
- 3. A *bimah* honor is extended at our congregation on the Shabbat prior to the *yahrzeit*.
- 4. A memorial candle is lit at home on sundown as the *yahrzeit* begins.
- 5. It is traditional to visit the grave on the anniversary of death or on a day prior to it. Similarly, such a visit should be made in the month of Elul (the month before Rosh Hashanah).
- 6. *Tzedakah* should be given as an expression of love in memory of the departed. By doing so, the lives and legacies of our loved ones are a continuous source of blessing.
- 7. The *yizkor* service is recited four times a year: Yom Kippur, Shemini Atzeret, Passover and Shavuot.

A Jew Today (1978)

For those of us who have lived the human and Jewish condition to its ultimate depths, there can be no doubt: at this point in history the Jewish people and the Jewish state are irrevocably linked; one could not survive the other. We have rarely been as united. And as alone.

And so the notion of a new collective catastrophe no longer seems preposterous. We already know that as far as we are concerned, the impossible is possible. When it comes to Jewish history, there is nothing unthinkable.

I say this reluctantly and for the first time. I have always placed the Holocaust on a mystical level, beyond human understanding. I have quarreled with friends for making certain easy analogies and comparisons in that domain. The concentration-camp phenomenon eludes the philosophers as much as it does the novelists, and it may not be dealt with lightly. I speak of it now, in connection with the present, only because Jewish destiny has once again become subject to discussion.

That is why I am afraid. Images from the past rise up and cloud current events. Blackmail in some quarters, abdication in others. Overt threats, hidden complicities. Friends who suddenly declare their neutrality. Neutrals whose hostility becomes apparent. The enemy who becomes ever more powerful and ever more attractive. If allowed to have his way — and he is — he will become the god of our cursed age, demanding — and obtaining — the future of a people as a sacrifice.
