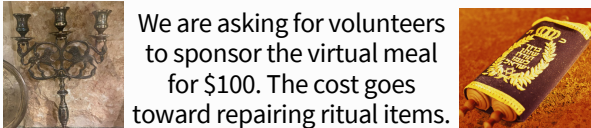

Fast of the First Born & Siyyum Bekhorim

Monday, April 22, 2024 at 8:15 a.m. | Samuel & Minnie Hyman Ballroom

All first-borns should fast on this day, usually the day before Pesah, in commemoration of the deliverance from Egypt of the Israelite firstborn. The Rabbi offers a *siyyum* (public completion of study) which is followed by a festive meal at which all present may eat, and once having eaten, a first born need not fast that day. The *siyyum* and the se'udat mitzvah will be held this year on Monday morning April 22 in person at 8:15 a.m., following the 7:30 a.m. morning minyan. **The Siyyum Breakfast is sponsored by Stanley & Cherie Maharam in loving memory of beloved parents and grandparents Bess & Aaron Maharam.**
